Conditions for the Issuance of a Barrister Practising Certificate in Tasmania

In addition to satisfying the requirements of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*, the Applicant must satisfy at least one of the following requirements:

1. Have successfully completed a period of training or pupillage, however described, which would qualify the applicant for the issuance of a barrister's practising certificate in another Australian jurisdiction, or
2. By undertaking a period of pupillage in a set of Chambers in Tasmania for a period of not less than eighteen months under the supervision of a barrister whose experience is acceptable to the Council of the Law Society of Tasmania, in consultation with the Tasmanian Independent Bar, or
3. Satisfy the Council of the Law Society of Tasmania, that the practitioner has sufficient and appropriate post-admission litigation experience to practise as a barrister in Tasmania.
