## Peter Thomas McDougall

A Launceston legal practitioner, Peter Thomas McDougall was struck off the Roll of Legal Practitioners today by order of Mr Justice Evans in the Supreme Court of Tasmania.

The order was made upon the application of the Law Society following the receipt of a number of complaints concerning the practitioner in 2005 and 2006.

On receipt of the complaints, the Law Society had applied to the court for the appointment of a manager to Mr McDougall's practice to protect client interests and client funds.

Following the investigation of the matters of complaint, the Society brought the application that was heard and determined by Mr Justice Evans this morning.

Details of the complaints are contained in his Honour's judgment which is available from the Supreme Court.
